## Oceanair to hook contractors with training expert

*OCEANAIR Distribution is running carbon dioxide technology training courses, teaching contractors how to install Sanyo's ECO CO2 heat pump system and Martin Hook is heading up the training.*



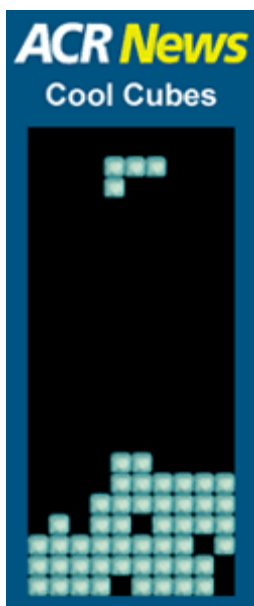
Martin Hook teaching the course

This one-day course highlights the operating principles of the carbon dioxide cycle, and how it differs from conventional refrigerant and gas-fired systems. It highlights the performance at lower ambients and gives installers practical experience of the systems in use.

Martin Hook is Oceanair's heat product manager. Richard Tyson, Oceanair managing director, said: "We are delighted to have Martin's expertise available to us. Given his experience and wide industry background, it is an endorsement that will command respect among the trade."
